Dr. Harold Beasley Memorial Award

Note to Readers: In the event of any inconsistency between this document and the legislation that affects chiropractic practice, the legislation governs.

Intent

To encourage graduating chiropractic students to develop a greater understanding of chiropractic legislation in Ontario, as well as CCO's policies.

Description of Policy

An annual award will be presented to a student at an accredited chiropractic educational institution in North America who intends to practise in Ontario for Proficiency in Ontario Jurisprudence. The award will be named the Dr. Harold Beasley Memorial Award. The winner shall have his/her fees for application and registration in Ontario waived for the first year.

Procedure

CCO will announce the award annually to all North American accredited chiropractic educational institutions.

The announcement will include:

- submission date; and
- the essay topic/project (to be determined based on consultation between the President and Registrar/General Counsel).

A CCO committee will select the winning entry. A copy of the winning entry will be published by CCO.
