Intent

To encourage dialogue between chiropractors and physiotherapists treating a patient simultaneously.

Description of Policy

CCO will advise all registrants who complain about cooperation by physiotherapists in the issue of concurrent care that they should dialogue with these physiotherapists to determine if there is contraindication to concurrent care. This is in keeping with a letter from the College of Physiotherapists of Ontario, dated May 12, 1995, which states:

“The advice we give to callers is that client care should be coordinated and this must be done by each provider, communicating with others involved in the client's (patient's) care.”
