Temporary Academic Certificate of Registration for Participation in a Faculty Exchange Program

Note to Readers: In the event of any inconsistency between this document and the legislation that affects chiropractic practice, the legislation governs.

Intent

To clarify the procedure for obtaining a temporary academic certificate of registration for non-Ontario chiropractors participating in a faculty exchange program or receiving a temporary faculty appointment at the Canadian Memorial Chiropractic College (CMCC).

Description of Policy

Non-Ontario licensed chiropractors who wish to participate in a faculty exchange program at CMCC or receive a temporary faculty appointment may apply to CCO for a temporary academic certificate of registration.

The fee for this certificate shall be \$250 and the certificate shall be issued for a period not longer than 12 weeks.

Procedure

Individuals wishing to apply for a temporary academic certificate of registration shall provide CCO with the following documentation:

- completed application form;
- a letter of good standing from their regulatory body;
- correspondence detailing the nature of the faculty exchange program, including the dates and duration of the program; and
- payment of \$250 in the form of a certified cheque or money order payable to the College of Chiropractors of Ontario.

The application will be reviewed by CCO's Registration Committee and applicants will be informed of the Committee's decision in writing.
