### Call for New Peer Assessors

*Interested in broadening your chiropractic experience? Are you a member registered in the General class of registration in good standing wishing to serve the public interest at the regulatory level?*

CCO is looking for members, interested in contributing to the College fulfilling its mandate to govern the profession in the public interest, to apply for the role of Peer Assessor.

CCO's Peer and Practice Assessment Program has been a powerful and successful, proactive way to ensure the public of Ontario receives the best chiropractic care possible from its members.

Developed and first implemented in 2001, under the guidance of Council through the Quality Assurance Committee, the Peer and Practice Assessment Program is an essential component of the Quality Assurance program, and an opportunity for all members to ensure their compliance with all regulations, standards or practice, policies and guidelines that govern the professional members through a proactive and non-punitive program.

Peer Assessors must meet the minimum qualifications, as outlined in [Policy P-051: Peer Assessors](#). **To maximize our outreach in a fiscally responsible manner, CCO is looking for members from the following geographical districts:**

- **Thunder Bay and Sault Saint Marie regions**
- **Owen Sound, Collingwood, Barrie and surrounding areas**
- **Bellville-Kingston and surrounding areas**

- **The Greater Toronto Area**
- **CCO District 5**
- **Windsor and surrounding areas**

Peer Assessors are front line ambassadors of the QA Committee, visiting members' offices, interacting one-on-one with members, and preparing reports to be submitted to the QA Committee. Training, for this role, is provided by CCO on an annual basis, at the CCO offices. **Please note that the next scheduled Peer Assessor Workshop is scheduled for January 27 and 28, 2023**, at the CCO offices in downtown Toronto (*attendance at this and other training opportunities are mandatory*). Per diems are provided and all reasonable expenses are covered when fulfilling duties as peer assessors. It is likely that successful candidates will begin early stages of their training in the autumn of 2022.
