Re: Reference to Performing Controlled Acts and Representing Yourself as Someone who is Authorized to Perform a Controlled Act

Dear Mr. Sabbi Haddiyan Wala:

It has been brought to the attention of the College of Chiropractors of Ontario (CCO) that you may be performing controlled acts that are authorized to chiropractors and other specific regulated health professions in Ontario and representing yourself as someone who is authorized to perform controlled acts or practise as a chiropractor.

In accordance with section 27(2) of the *Regulated Health Professions Act, 1991* and sections 4 and 9 of the *Chiropractic Act, 1991*, it is a regulatory requirement that any individual in Ontario who:

- uses the title of chiropractor, a variation or abbreviation or an equivalent in a different language,
- hold himself or herself out as a person who is qualified to practise in Ontario as a chiropractor or in a specialty of chiropractic, or
- performs the controlled act of “moving the joints of the spine beyond the individual’s usual physiological range of motion using a fast, low amplitude thrust”
be a member of CCO or another health regulatory college that has the authority to perform this controlled act.

To avoid any further possible allegation or legal action associated with practising chiropractic or performing a controlled act without a certificate of registration, CCO advises that you ensure that there are no communications or representations to the public or on your website or social media that you are a chiropractor, are practising chiropractic, or performing a controlled act. As well, please ensure that you are not practising as a chiropractor or performing any controlled acts that are authorized to chiropractors in Ontario.
