I am Dr. Sarah Green, co-owner of Elmira Family Chiropractic, a community-based practice rooted in small-town values of integrity, respect, transparency, and honesty. I have had the privilege of serving on CCO Council since 2020. In practice, I work with patients from diverse backgrounds and take time to understand their goals, values, and concerns. This patient-centred approach informs my regulatory work, particularly in matters related to professional conduct, patient safety, and fairness in process.
